Colleges Scotland's Statement on the Good College Governance Report

Shona Struthers, Chief Executive, Colleges Scotland said:

“Good governance must lie at the heart of the college sector to build public trust and deliver vital services to students, employers and communities. There has already been a sea-change in the way that colleges are governed and the sector itself has embraced the need to focus on achieving the highest standards of governance. A Code of Good Governance for Scotland's Colleges has been developed and the sector's Good Governance Steering Group continues to meet to oversee its implementation and review. In addition, a series of national board development workshops are underway and we will be working with unions to review the sector's Staff Governance Standard.

“The Good College Governance report from the Scottish Government's taskforce will build on this good work to ensure that we have systems and clear accountability fit for a modern college sector.”
